Executive Order 001

Establishing the Office of the Principal Advisor to the President on Scientific & Environmental Policy and Strategy

Whereas the development of policy relating to the understanding and advancement of science, and the safeguarding of the land we live on, are both critical endeavors of any state and ones requiring comprehensive analysis and coordinated action,

Whereas the Republic of Soundland must be prepared to meet head-on the increasing global and ecological challenges brought by the climate crisis,

Now, Therefore, by the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and laws of the Republic of Soundland, and to enhance and inform our nation's scientific and environmental policy and capabilities, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1. Establishment. The position of the Principal Advisor to the President on Scientific & Environmental Policy and Strategy is hereby established. The office of the Principal Advisor shall exist within the body of the Office of the President.

Section 2. Appointment. The Principal Advisor to the President on Scientific & Environmental Policy and Strategy shall be appointed by the President and will serve at the President's discretion. The Principal Advisor shall report directly to the President.

Section 3. Responsibilities. The Principal Advisor shall -

- (a) Advise the President on matters of scientific and environmental policy and research, and the advancement of related fields;
- (b) Develop, inform and recommend government policies on scientific and environmental matters;

- (c) Monitor the impacts of government policy and acts of the National Senate on scientific and environmental matters, and the effectiveness of relevant policies and programs;
- (d) Facilitate collaboration and communication among governmental agencies, national institutions, and stakeholders;
- (e) Represent the President in discussions with stakeholders on scientific and environmental matters;
- (f) With presidential authorization, represent the President in international discussions and negotiations on scientific and environmental matters.
- (g) Promote public understanding of scientific and environmental matters, policy and advancements.

Section 4. *Office of the Principal Advisor.* The Principal Advisor may appoint members to their office to assist them in their duties.
